## ***SERMON OUTLINE***

Introduction: "Dare to be a Daniel, dare to stand alone"; will we stand alone in the judgment?

- I. Christians' views of the judgment.
  - A. Adventist views, e.g., Great Controversy, 488.
  - B. Other Christians' views.
- II. The Bible's view of the judgment.
  - A. The judgment is part of the eternal good news. Revelation 14:6-7; Psalm 96:11-13, John 4:16-18.
  - B. God's activities as Judge in the Bible. Genesis 3:15; 4:15; Judges 2:18; Daniel 7:21-22.
    1. The pattern: God conducts the judgment to defend, not defeat, His people.
  - C. Vindication versus condemnation: John 5:24; 2 Corinthians 5:10.
    1. The negative aspect of the judgment for God. John 3:19-21.
- III. What to do about the judgment message: share the eternal good news. Psalm 96:11-13.
